Thank God for His love and goodness towards LCC. Appreciate the various ways He has helped us. Thank Him for the troubles He has put away from us. Declare appreciation for the foundation of LCC in Christ and His blood that remains our covering. Pray that Jesus Christ and His sacrifice on the cross and His resurrection will be our boast. Psalm 121:1-8; Romans 5:3-5; Galatians 6:14
 That as we call on the name, Jesus Christ, the power in that name will move to cause change, renew, strengthen and bring deliverance. Ask that Jesus Christ will cause His resurrection power bring a revival like we have never encountered. Phil. 2:10-12; Acts 4:12; Psalm 28:7
 Thank the Holy Spirit for the help He has given us thus far. That Holy Spirit will help us move

forward daily towards realisation of the vision of LCC. Pray that there will be visible difference in the lives of people as they come to fellowship with us. Pray for impactful encounters. 2 Corinthians 5:17; 2 Chron. 26:16; Exodus 15:2

4. That God will awaken those who are lukewarm into their responsibility as labourers in God's vineyard for more impact. That God will grow and pull in more labourers that will be used for His glory. Matt. 9:37-38; John 4:34-38

5. That there will be adequate resources to effectively care for and nurture new comers especially those who give their lives to Jesus Christ. That all who come to worship with us will encounter God like they have never done. Phil 3:10; John 10:1-16; 2 Corinthians 9:8

6. That our members and others alike will experience God's preservation. That we will be divinely preserved. Pray against every form of sicknesses, accidents and other forms of problems. Pray that none of these will come near us and that the year will end in joyous celebration for us. That will go out in safety and come in safety. Psalm 62:5-8; Psalm 28:7; Prov. 21:31

7. That God will promote His kingdom and love in our children. That they will walk in excellence, know God and do exploits in His name. That they will be honoured vessels that God will use to draw souls into His kingdom and use for signs and wonders. Daniel 11:32; 2 Tim. 2:20-22
8. Ask God to make His presence and power evident in our congregation and others in a more visible way. Pray for fresh anointing upon every LCC member. Ask the Holy Spirit to make the miracles and other wonderful things we read and hear be an integral part of our work. Acts 5:12-16;

Acts 10:38; Isaiah 10:27

9. That God will arrest any power that is intended to cause us distraction in any form. Close any channel and ask that no contrary power will have their way your, life family, church or your nation. Luke 10:19; Matthew 18:18-20

10. Pray that the Holy Spirit will cause a harvest of souls and increase in number of persons coming to LCC and other congregation. That they will be changed as they come. Ask God to draw people in especially those yet to encounter the love and salvation available in Jesus Christ. Acts 2:41, 5:14

11. Thank the Holy Spirit for His wonderful gifts meant to edify the church. Ask Him to make these gifts common place in those who desire it them, that people will engage those they already have. Pray that the total package will be present and that they will be used under submission to Him and with humility and love. 1 Peter 4:10; 1 Corinthians 12:1-31; James 1:17

12. Ask God to show mercy to those whose heart's have become hardened to the gospel. Ask that they will have understanding and realise the truth inherent in the gospel. Ask God to erase every lie they have believed and make them see the necessity of Jesus Christ in their lives and be moved by the Holy Spirit unto Jesus. That we will effectively play our part in evangelism. Ezekiel 11:19; Psalm 51:10; Matt. 28:19-20

13. Pray that LCC shall be a place of deliverance and victory especially for those who have been lost. Ask that people's hearts are softened to hear and joyfully receive the gospel and ultimately Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. Ask the Holy Spirit to convict and move the unsaved into Christian assemblies including LCC. Ask that He will be present to make God's power real to those in doubt. Romans 8:11; Ezekiel 36:26-37; John 16:8-9; Acts 4:31; Isaiah 49:24.25

14. Thank God for the vision of LCC which is, "To transform lives through Jesus Christ and build a people after God's heart". Pray that this vision will be daily evident as people fellowship in LCC, that they will be able to clearly see the remarkable changes that God has made possible in their lives. Ask the Holy Spirit to daily break us and shape us into worthy vessels and enabling holiness and accountability. Pray against any power that may try to stand on the way of realisation of this vision. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us shine.Psalm 54:4; Jeremiah 18:1-6; Habakkuk 2:3; John 16:33 15. Pray that those who see LCC as their home church and others who come to fellowship with us will be so much impacted that they will be easily distinguished as they shine such that their Christlike nature is visible for all to see. Pray for grace to contend and overcome every form of opposition that may try to sabotage them. Ask that the Holy Spirit will be there to help at all times and we always resort to Him. Jude 1:3; 2 Cor. 5:17; Colossians 2:15; John 15:26-27

16. Pray against every evil voices trying to raise failures and sins from the past. Ask the Holy Spirit to silence them. Pray that there will be no doubt about the forgiveness that God has shown us at reception of Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour. That every spirit of guilt and whatever damage they have caused will be wiped out and a clear conscience will be established. Psalm 143:12; Psalm 103:12-14; Heb. 10:22

17. Ask that disciples and spiritual warriors are raised continually in LCC. That all who are part of LCC will will live lives sold out totally unto Jesus Christ. That there will be grace to put the things of the world behind and put God always in focus. Pray against distractions and patterns that do not align with God's plan for us. Romans 12:2; Isaiah 40:31; Phil.1:21.30

18. Thank Him for being the One who is All Sufficient. Ask for grace to seek God with your whole heart. Thank Him for being the one who is able to do all things and give life. Pray that life will flow in LCC and His church. Ask for grace to find sufficiency only in God. Pray against whatever causes worry and anxiety. Isaiah 41:10; Mark 12:30; Deut. 6:5; Phil. 4:13; Psalm 17:15, 55:22

19. Pray that we shall be significantly blessed in this last quarter. Ask God to enlarge you and His church. Ask God to enlarge our area of influence and be enabled and helped to use such influence to boldly share the gospel and show love to the weary and broken. Ask that God will make us vessels of tremendous blessing and carriers of hope. 2 Tim. 4:2; Psalm 1:1; Jeremiah 17:7; Matt. 5:16; 2 Timothy 2:21

20. Thank God that He makes all things beautiful as His power moves in situations that have been seen as impossible or difficult. Thank Him for His love and sovereignty. Ask God to change the situation of the children we have been praying for. Ask that there will be a new report that is significantly different from what we can see as His power work in them. Ask God to erase every form of anxiety but rather grow faith in us. Eccl. 3:11; Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:17

21. Ask the Holy Spirit to pour His anointing and manifest His power into everyone serving in LCC. Pray for unity and that the life of each person will project Jesus' love, His goodness and power. Ask for His help and direction that will facilitate individual development and growth of the work like never before. Ask God to also pull in Finnish people. Pray for helpers. Isaiah 41:10; 1 Peter 3:8; Luke 4:18; 1 Cor.3:5-8; John 6:44; 1 Chron. 12:22

22. That the desire for a facility of ours to which we have been giving towards over the years will be realised. Thank God for all who have been a part of this and how much we have gathered. Pray that God will help us and surprise in actualising this desire. Psalm 20:4; Psalm 37:4; Prov.3:5-8; Matt. 6:25-26

23. Pray for the equipping of all who are serving. Ask God to help us all work and serve as faithful stewards who can be trusted. Ask the Holy Spirit to enable the leaders to know how to order things and care adequately for the flock. Ask for ministering and nurturing grace. Ask the Holy Spirit to give the word that will be preached. Pray that each will hear and clearly know what the Holy Spirit is saying and willingly do as directed. 2 Cor. 12:9; Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 5:1-10

24. Pray for each department in LCC. Ask for wisdom to flow in those serving in these departments. That there will be clear understanding of what to do, how and when to do things. Prov. 16:9; Psalm 32:8

25. Pray against distractions and whatever is intended to weaken our hands or cause discouragement. Ask that every strategy to sabotage us or His work will be exposed and wisdom will be available to deal with such. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us know how to do things and also help us grow in unity. Nehemiah 6:9-14; 1 Cor. 1:10; Ephes. 4:1-32; Isaiah 30:21
26. Ask the Holy Spirit to raise us as faithful sons and daughters who are intentionally living to glorify God and contributing towards the edification of the body and evangelism. Pray for God's purifying fire to burn in our midst and continue to refine us. Ask for a reawakening, fervent desire and commitment and fruitfulness. That we live out the word. 1 Cor. 4:2; Luke 16:10; Heb. 10:23; Titus 2:11-14

27. Pray for marriages to flourish in LCC. Ask God to take away personality challenges and the manipulative hands of the enemy that causes tension and problems in marriages. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us be selfless and godly to our spouse. Ask that our marriages will be shielded by the name and blood of Jesus Christ and that there will be grace to triumph in times of testing. Pray that God will guide and bless those seeking life partners with that He has ordained for them. Heb. 13:4; Prov. 18:22; Ephes. 5:22-33; Proverbs 19:14

28. Pray against the spirit of immorality and sexual recklessness. Pray against the root of any form of addiction and hidden habits that have become a challenge to overcome. Ask that God will preserve us from contamination of the ways of the world. That His presence in us will enable us overcome every evil He will try to push to us. Gal. 5:19-21; 1 Cor. 6:18; 1 Thess. 4:3-5 29. Pray that each one in LCC will grow in the love, honour, fear and reverence of God. Pray that God will have His deserved place in our hearts and He will be daily celebrated without any limitation. Pray that our congregation will be a healthy place of worship where people are well nourished. Pray for supply of spiritual milk and meat that will facilitate healthy growth into maturity. 1 Peter 3:9; 2 John 1:6; John 6:27; 1 Peter 2:2; Heb. 5:11-15

30. Ask God to frustrate all adversaries and make useless their strategies and every tools that they engage. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us submit to Him and walk circumspectly knowing who we are and living as His children purchased with the blood. Pray that we will have the grace to bring forth what God has revealed. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us leave a distinct mark in this nation and beyond in such a way that people's lives experience remarkable difference as we live as salt to season lives. Psalm 33:10; Nehemiah 4:15; Job 5:12-14
