

2025 OCTOBER FAST AND PRAYERS: WEDNESDAY 8th OCTOBER

[Exalt God and thank His for Jesus Christ, take time in worship to begin today's fast](#)

1. Thank God for bringing you into this day and this quarter. Thank Him for preservation and the unfailing love you have enjoyed and special time of intimate fellowship that we all will be having with Him today. Confess any known sin you are aware of and ask for mercy and cleansing with the blood of Jesus. Glorify Jesus Christ and invite Him to be with us and that His name will quench all opposition. [Ephesians. 1:7; Psalm 100:4; Lamentations 3:22–23; 1 John 1:9; Philippians 2:9–10](#)
2. Thank the Holy Spirit for His role in building and equipping the church. Ask Him to take charge of you and others involved in this fast. Pray that His impact you will be as He did the Disciples, changing Peter to such extent that he could powerfully, boldly and tactically share the gospel that thousands gave their lives to Christ. Pray that there will be visible indicators to enable you see growth in your spiritual and other aspects of life. [Acts 1:8; John 14:26; 2 Corinthians 3:18](#)

3. Pray for consistency to walk as peculiar person and a royal priest and to be fully equipped with the gifts that you desire. Pray that you will step beyond the nominal and walk as the Holy Spirit leads. Ask Him to help you make impact. Pray that those who come to fellowship in LCC will continually experience transformation into God's image as we behold His glory [1 Peter 2:9; Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 3:18; Galatians 5:25](#)
4. Present your goals and desires for the year before God. Thank Him for those that have been accomplished. Pray for grace and relevant resources needed to achieve the remainder. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you. Pray against discouragement and the spirit that resists ability to complete tasks. Declare loudly to yourself, "I am not a quitter, I will complete all that God has set on my mind".

5. Pray for increased anointing and strength for the LCC workers. Ask the Holy Spirit to cause a revival in you, in LCC and in the universal church. Pray that souls will be drawn in in multitudes, convicted by the Holy Spirit and submit to Jesus Christ. Pray for love, truth and unity in the church and grace to stick together to accomplish the task that Jesus Christ has put in our hands. Pray for discernment and that uncommon favour. 6. Pray for pruning unto growth and increase. Ask for a heart that understands the need for personal evangelism and open doors to share the gospel. Pray against every schemes of the devil and whatever he has designed against the church during this quarter. Pray that God's hedge around us will even be further increased. Pray for good health and consistency in your walk with the Lord. .

7. Pray for four nations and 4 churches as the Holy Spirit leads you to. Pray for peace in crisis ridden places around the world. Ask God to raising men and women after His heart in His church and in leadership internationally. Pray for congregations that are in crisis, ask the Holy Spirit to step in and bring the surpassing peace and intervention of God. Commit all our activities during this quarter unto the Lord, Pray for equipping of the saints and an overflow of testimonies this quarter.
