

2026 JANUARY FAST AND PRAYERS: 28TH JANUARY

Offer songs of worship and praise unto the Lord. Thank Him for this

1. Thank the Lord for this fourth day of the year opening fast, thank Him for the mercy He has shown us over the previous days of fast. Ask Him for abundant grace and mercy that will enable success for this final day. Thank the Lord Jesus Christ for His wonderful love and sacrifice that made redemption possible for you. Express gratitude for this and ask Him to cleanse you today and help you focus and enjoy the day. [Romans 5:8; Hebrews 9:22](#);

2. Thank the Holy Spirit for enabling us have these days of fast to begin the year. Ask the Him to help you set God and all that pertains to Him as priority. Pray for grace to adequately use the resources He has given you with reverence and impact. What do you want to change in you this year? How do you desire to be used for edification of the body and to draw souls into the kingdom.? Express this to God [Psalm 27:4; 1 Peter 4:10; Matthew 6:33; Zechariah 4:6](#)

3. Ask God to save you from mockery and self destructive choices. Pray that your life will only bring glory to God and the body of Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you deal with any unwholesome desires. Pray that you will not self sabotage, pray that anyone who is in the grip of any addiction or destructive behaviour shall have their understanding open and be set free.

4. Pray for a revitalized prayer life in your life and across our church. Pray for an awakening and burden to pray and stand in intercession like never before. Pray for a more intimate relationship and one that will help you enjoy a more fulfilling relationship with Him. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you know what to let go so that your walk with God will shift into a new dimension. [Colossians 4:2; Ezekiel 22:30; Hebrews 12:1; Psalm 27:8](#)

5. Express your love unto God in whatever way the Spirit lays on your heart. Ask that this love will be further reinforced. Pray that God's presence will be overwhelming at any time and place we gather to worship Him or make His name known this year. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach us and open our eyes and understanding such that we will be able take new territories. [Deuteronomy 6:5; Romans 5:5; Exodus 33:14; Psalm 119:34](#)

6. Pray for a fervent and unapologetic church where God's word is lived out to its fullest. A body where the word is taught without any embellishment or personal gain. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us engage all within us to do what God directs, pray that His power will strengthen us and His hands will uphold us and His voice will guide and shape. 7. Ask God to prepare every member and worker in LCC for the responsibilities He has for us this year. Pray for wisdom and grace for the journey. Pray that the joy of the Lord will abound . Ask the Holy Spirit help you enjoy peace and walk in righteousness. Pray that this year will be outstandingly blessed. Recommit the prayers points you presented at the beginning of the year. Pray for the wellbeing of this nation and ask that God will allow His light shine here and that He will help this nation in remarkable ways beginning from turning the hearts of the people unto Him.
